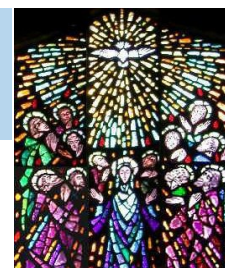

Parish Pilgrimage to Lisieux by Coach April 23rd – 26th 2022

The cost of the Pilgrimage is £330 sharing and £360 for a single room. Pilgrimage to Lourdes and Nevers by Coach June 4th – 11th 2022

(Pick up in Nottingham, Derby and Leicester)

The cost is £670 per person. This price includes Coach and Ferry travel, overnight stay with Bed and Breakfast at the Welcome Break hotel in Orleans on the way out, full board at the Hotel Irlande in Lourdes, half board at the Kyriad Hotel in Nevers on the way back. In addition to this there's an optional excursion to Gavarnie, a Ski Resort in the Pyrenees.

The Friary Winter Appeal- As the nights get colder the cost of living is increasing. Energy bills and fuel costs are spiralling causing income to be stretched. Many are reliant on this income, often for issues around physical and mental health. The Friary has recognised the need to focus on preventative work and as such, we have now launched our Advice Centre to complement the work in our Drop-In Centre. We are working to support people with issues around benefits, housing and debt. This is already starting to make a difference and those who could have ended up on the streets are being supported.

The Friary is here to provide both practical and emotional support and it is the emphasis on both that makes the real difference. To many people we see, without the time invested with them, they feel there are few other places to turn.

The pandemic has brought extra support for rough sleepers with increased accommodation provision this Winter. This is so welcomed for those entrenched rough sleepers. It will give them space and support to consider the future. It can't help everyone though and the Friary is here to help those who will still be in need.
