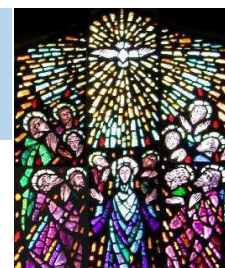

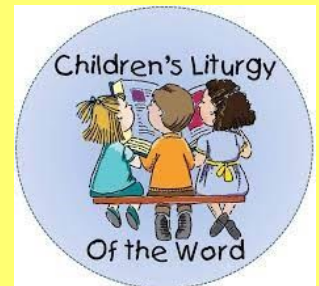
OUR LADY OF GRACE ACTIVITIES
