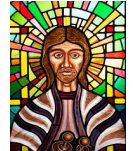

**Community of the Annunciation**

**of Rushcliffe Steering Group meeting**

All four churches' PPC representatives met with Fr. John for a final steering meeting this week to confirm they had agreed and ratified the timeline on the re-structure of our new parish and the new parish name, 'The Annunciation'. All documentation will be presented to the Bishop's Secretary Fr. Simon Gillespie at Deanery a meeting next week.

Fr. John Martin has to formally petition Bishop Patrick to create one new parish out of the current four parishes. The Bishop then has to consult with the Council of Priests, a group of about 20 priests representing all the areas of our Diocese, before he can make a final decision.

The meeting also discussed the setting up of a new parish council for the four churches and inviting new parishioners to join the parish council. Each church needs to have two representatives.

The next new PPC will be at the Holy Spirit on 4th October. If you would like to represent your church please speak with Fr. John or present PPC Chairs.

**CAFOD** has launched a Pakistan Floods Appeal - to get funds to local experts who are on the ground helping those most in need of food and emergency medical assistance.
