

We hope you all had a good Summer. Welcome to the newly formed Community of the Annunciation of Rushcliffe! Four churches united together as one. We hope that we will grow together and help each other in keeping our faith and spirituality strong, and our community thriving. We must also be patient with each other and recognise that this is a big change, and it is a good thing and benefits us all, but it will take time for us all to adjust. Our new parish name is yet to be official, we consulted you this Summer with suggestions, thank you for your support. Bishop Patrick McKinney decided on a our new parish name which is 'Parish of the Annunciation' once the Canonical process is finished. We will keep you informed, as soon as we know.

We warmly welcome our new Priests Fr. John Martin (Parish Priest) and Fr. Liam Carpenter (Assistant Priest). Fr. John will be living in the Presbytery at St Anne's in Radcliffe-on- Trent and Fr. Liam in the Presbytery in West Bridgford. We wish them firm hope and strength in their new priestly vocation, and that we too as parishioners look to support them both with renewed positivity as a new four church community.

Fr. John Martin -Parish Priest

I was born in Dublin, Ireland, both my parents were Dubliners. I am one of eight siblings, I have two brothers Paul and Thomas and five sisters, Breda, Joan Catherine, Rita and Lorraine. Seven of us were born in Ireland and my youngest brother Paul was born in the City Hospital, Nottingham. My family arrived in Nottingham in 1968 when I was nine

years old. I went to Saint Mary's Junior



School, on Derby Road, by the Cathedral and from there I went to Bishop Dunn, Secondary School, in Aspley. While at school I felt God was calling me to religious life and after I left school in 1975 and I went to train as a chef at Nazareth House, Nottingham and in my final year of training I felt I had to answer God's call and so I entered the Hospitaller Order of Saint John of John 29th September 1978.

After doing my discernment, noviciate, simple and solemn profession, I did my degree BSc, Diploma, in Social Worker, and served as The Provincial of the English Province for 12 years. I felt the call to priesthood within my call as a Brother of Saint John of God. The Order did not wish at that time to Ordain any more Brothers at that time and I therefore with a heavy heart, left the Order to follow God's call into the Diocesan Priesthood. I study at Oscott Seminary Birmingham and was ordained to the Sacred Priesthood on 13th July 2013 by Bishop Malcom McMahon OP.

After Ordination, Bishop Malcom appointed me, his Chaplain to the Youth Service, where I spent two very happy years, I had never worked children. All my 33 years of working life in the Order was spent looking after adults and in administration.

I fulfilled my Diaconate training at the Parish of Saint Albans under the guidance of Fr Paul Newman and what a good grounding he and the parish gave me. In the very short 9 years I have been a Priest, I have worked in various parishes as both Deacon and Priest: Saint Albans-Derby, The Church on Oakwood-Derby, Christ the King-Mackworth, All Saints-Ashbourne, Saint Mary on the Sea-Grimsby, Saint Pius X-Grimsby, Saint Thomas Fisher-Grimsby, Corpus Christi-Cleethorpes, Our Lady Star of the Sea-Immingham, Saint Barnabas Cathedral-Nottingham.

I am not a football man, so you don't have to worry about Leicester, Forest or County, with me! I will always be ready to console you!

I enjoy walking, reading, Irish folk music, cooking when I can, and going for a gentle bike ride!

My passion is to walk beside you on your Christian Journey, to inspire, support, be present, to listen and together encounter Christ in each other, to be bold and be Missionery outward looking and build up the Kingdom of God in our community of The Annunciation! May Jesus, Mary and Joseph guide us with the power and grace of the Holy Spirit as we come to know one another in our new setup of the Church's of The Annunciation! Peace. Fr. John.

Fr Liam Carpenter- Assistant Priest

Hello! I am Fr Liam, and I am delighted to have been appointed as Assistant Priest to the Catholic Community of the Annunciation, Rushcliffe at such an exciting time in the lives of our 4 parishes. I was born on 7th June 1985 in Leicestershire, the eldest child of Bill and Gaynor Carpenter. I have a younger brother called Tom who was born in 1991, and twin half siblings Islam and Yasmin who were born in 1995.



Although I was baptised as a 3-month-old baby, I was not raised in the practice of the Catholic Faith. However, when I was 12, partly due to the grace of baptism that had lain dormant in me, and the influence and inspiration of gifted RE teachers at English Martyr's School in Leicester I decided to return independently to the practice of the faith, and so took myself off to Mass at St Peter's Church on Hinckley Road. I made my first confession in 1997, coincidentally to Fr Michael Brown - no doubt the trauma of the event has led him to retire! Fr John McCay also presided at my late Grandmother's funeral in 2005, so the bonds of connectedness between our outgoing clergy are precious to me.

Like Fr John Martin, during my teenage years I also began to feel a pull towards the religious life. Following university study in London, I became a Benedictine Monk at St Augustine's Abbey in Ramsgate in 2006, moving in 2010 to St Michael's Abbey in Farnborough. By 2013 I was working as Guest-Master of the monastery and enjoyed speaking to different groups who visited and giving retreat days to the local school children. It was during this time that I began to feel a call to serve God as a Priest, and so I sought permission to return to the Diocese of Nottingham and begin seminary formation. During this period of discernment, I was encouraged and supported by a 'youngish' Deacon I met at an ordination in Leicester - Deacon John Martin!

After studies at St Mary's College Oscott, during which I worked as RC Chaplain to HMP Birmingham for two years, I was ordained priest alongside Fr John Owens on 6th July 2019, the feast of St Maria Goretti, in St Barnabas Cathedral at the hands of Bishop Patrick Mckinney. Following ordination, I served 4 parishes in North Lincolnshire residing at St Bernadette's in Scunthorpe, until more recently serving as Assistant Priest in the parish of the Holy Family here in Nottingham.

I am also the Assistant Vocations Director, working alongside Fr Neil Peoples in this important work. (continued on page 4))
