Statement from Bishop Patrick regarding Holy Communion

Communicants have the right to choose whether they receive Holy Communion either on the tongue or the hand. 'The communicant replies, Amen and receives the Sacrament either on the tongue or where is allowed, in the hand, the choice lying with the communicant'.

The choice within the Bishop's Conference of England and Wales had been restricted during Covid, but now belongs once again to the communicant.
