The Apostolic Penitentiary has announced that Pope Francis has granted a Plenary Indulgence for the faithful who take part in the Third World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. Cardinal Kevin Joseph Farrell, Prefect of the Dicastery for the Laity, Family, and Life, has requested that a Plenary Indulgence be granted to Catholics taking part in the upcoming Third World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, which was instituted by Pope Francis. The World Day will be celebrated on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> July under the theme “His mercy is from age to age” (Luke 1:50).

A plenary indulgence offers remission of the temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven, which can be applied to oneself or to the souls in Purgatory.
