Teach me how to love and, above all, teach me to have an attitude of hope."

Celebrate the seasons of Advent and Christmas - Schedule of Masses and Services Details can be found on the Parish website or Poster at the Church.

My friends our Gospel text for this Sunday contains two sections. The first is devoted to an introduction to the mission of the last of the prophets, Saint John the Baptist, and the second section is concerned with how John the Baptist witnesses to Christ, the Anointed Messiah. We need to bear witness to Christ the Light. Our mission, as brothers and sisters of Christ and members of his Church, is to reflect Christ's Light to others, just as the moon reflects the light of the sun.



It is especially important during the Advent season that we reflect Christ's sharing love and his unconditional forgiveness through our lives. There are too many people who live in darkness and poverty, and who lack real freedom because of their addictions and bad choices. There are others who are deafened and blinded by the cheap attractions of this world. Many others feel lonely, unwanted, rejected, and marginalized.

This is where you become a true Light of Christ to illumine the lives of all these brothers and sisters during this Advent season through our sharing love, overflowing mercy, unconditional forgiveness, and humble service. We will be able to accomplish this witnessing mission of radiating Christ's Light only by repenting of our sins, asking God's pardon every day, and by renewing our lives through our daily prayers, by frequenting the Sacrament of Reconciliation, by attending and taking part in the Eucharistic celebration, by reading the Bible daily in meditative, prayerful fashion, and by performing the corporal and spiritual works of mercy! Through all these acts of love you will radiate the Joy and love of the Christ Child, this Christmas.
